The decision was prompted by increasingly paying for lighting cross rentals for various projects, so the time was right for Lucidity to make its own investment.

"I wanted versatile fixtures that were appropriate for all environments" explained Paul who wanted an efficient ROI, so he examined the flexibility of the fixtures vs. what people were requesting the most!

Both Pointes and LEDWash 300s are extremely popular in South Africa, and DWR has worked hard to ensure that the Robe brand has been adopted in all sectors of the industry.

"The fixtures are great for corporate environments and ideal also for large scale productions" he comments, adding that most SA freelancers are familiar with Robe's products and also highly recommend them.
